Is Your Phone Listening To You?

Virtual assistant apps like Siri, Google Assistant, Alexa, and Cortana do listen to users to provide assistance, such as making calls or sending texts. Additionally, phones track conversations to serve personalized ads, just like search engines track our activity.

Phones legally listen to us when we give consent through terms and conditions when downloading apps or software updates. However, some spyware or malware can illegally infect smartphones to listen to users. To limit permissions given to applications, users can review microphone permissions granted and disable virtual assistants.

To disable the microphone on an iPhone, go to Settings > Siri & Search and toggle off "Listen for 'Hey Siri,'" "Press Side button for Siri," and "Allow Siri When Locked." On Android devices, go to Settings > Google > Account Services > Search, Assistant & Voice > Voice > Voice Match and toggle off "Hey Google."

To disable microphone access across applications, users can navigate to the specific application settings and toggle off the microphone permission.

Here are some helpful privacy tips for smart phones:

- Verify the apps you download and only download apps from official stores.
- Review app permissions to determine whether or not specific applications really need access to your microphone and, in turn, access to your conversations.
- Delete your voice request history on Google Assistant.
- Consider using a VPN to encrypt your manual browsing activity.
- Keep your software up to date.

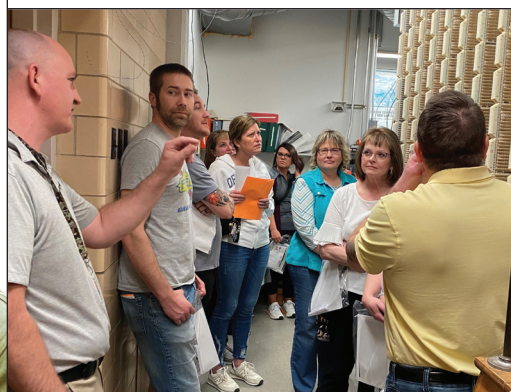
